## **Heike Lober – The personal story of Juno, a puppy of only 12 weeks old**

An ultrasound was made, and they were convinced that there was „foreign body tissue“ in the Small Intestine. Juno was operated, with as a result that there was no foreign body tissue present. What they saw on the X-ray and ultrasound was the swollen gastric outlet.

There was – exactly the same as in the Small Testine – an unmistakable inflammation. In the affected region they found mucous, clear, smelly stool.


Examination of the feces, the blood and the tissue (for bacteria) , and also for chronic inflammation diseases like the „Disease of Crohn“ were without any result (all negative).

So where did this inflammation come from, with these for the little one far reaching effects? My first thought was „Maybe it’s the Bravecto“, but the vet and the animal clinic had the opinion that this was not the cause.

My consideration for this thought was that when the testines activity is being reduced by this med (even if this just happens in individual cases), the processing of fluids stops, and this way a great inflammation can occur without a bacterial pathogenic source.

We hope that there will be no more side effects, and that the little Juno will have no further, and no permanent physical damage.

After all the investigations no reason was found for his inflammation, and so it is very likely that Bravecto was the reason for this. My boss, a doctor in TCM (Traditional Chinese Medicine), said immediately after I told her: This is from Bravecto.
