
BRAVECTO - Serious side effects The personal story of "Layla" (024)

I gave my 11 year old Cocker Spaniel Layla a 3 month Bravecto and she became very sick 4 hours after her dose. She had been having seizures, weakness of the rear legs collapsing and would not eat.

After a visit to the vet it seems as if she had auto immune anemia. Her blood levels were 26 and within one day dropped to a 17. The next day her packed blood cell levels dropped to 14. Later that same day I had to take her back for another recheck and her level dropped to 11.

I had to leave my sweet girl at the vet over night for a blood transfusion. Due to her being so sick the vet could not get a iv in to give her blood and had to drill through her bone to allow the blood to be given. I picked her up the next morning and brought her home hoping she would recover.

As I laid next to her on the kitchen floor she was getting worse. I had to give her water with a syringe and she was so very thirsty yet unable to drink on her own. She began to defecate black tarry stool all over herself followed by urinating blood as she laid in her bed unable to move.

By midnight she started to vomit blood so I rushed her to the emergency vet. I was told that she was in so much pain and suffering. I had to make the hardest decision to have her put to sleep.

The worst part was actually seeing tears rolling down her face on our way to the vet. I no longer have my Layla to hold and love. She was completely fine before I gave her the bravecto.

I know this so called flea and tick preventative took her away from me. My heart is broken and my Faith is gone. Please do not give your pets this chewable pill if you love them.

I love you Layla and mommy is so very sorry I did not do my research first. Please forgive me my sweet girl.
